

# Year 2 Curriculum News

## Writing:

This half-term, we shall be looking at a few different writing styles to consolidate the children's learning across Year 2. This shall include, re-writing a narrative based around the book 'Biscuit Bear' by Mini Grey, an explanation text on making a recipe and creating some shape poetry. They will also be writing 'Little Red Hen' again to show some of the skills they have learnt this year.

## Maths

This half-term, children will be looking at position and direction within Geometry and understanding turns. They will also be looking at statistics and completing a variety of data collection techniques. As we near the end of the academic year, children will have the chance to consolidate all their learning this year and embed the concrete methods they will require going into Year 3.

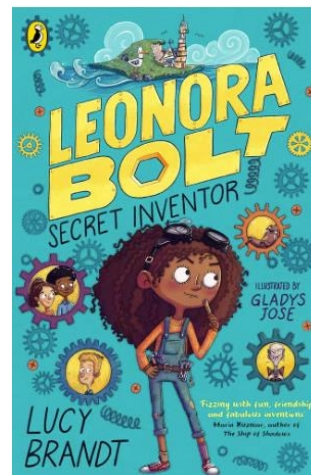
## Science

In science, children will be thinking and examining how to stay healthy. They will be able to describe the importance of exercise for humans and describe the basic needs for animals and humans needed for survival.

## Reading

This half term, we shall be regularly reading 'Lenora Bolt Secret Inventor' by Lucy Brandt.

The children will have various books in whole-class guided reading lessons accompanied by various reading comprehensions.



## Other learning

This half-term's topic will be aviation and studying the first airplane flight in History. We shall be looking at early pioneers, including the Wright Brothers. An interesting part of our studies will also be looking at sculpture in art and transforming objects into sculptures. Plus, we shall be talking and remaining open around the transition into Year 3 and supporting the children in PSHE around this change into KS2.
