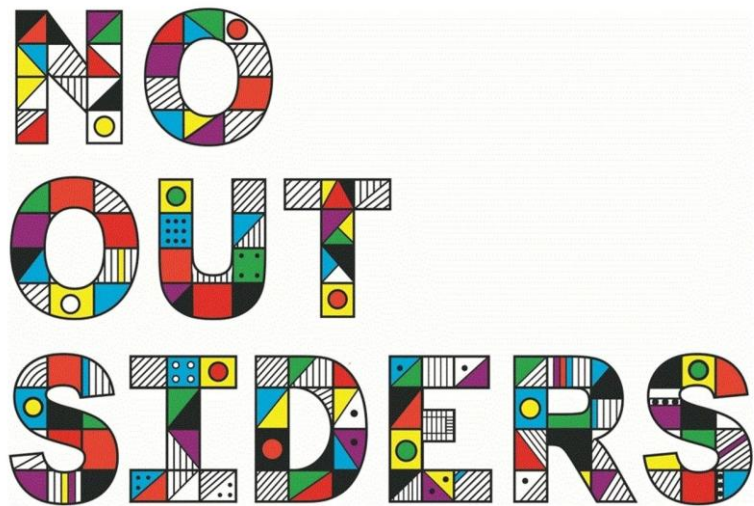

It's special because it has yellow feathers, not black and white.

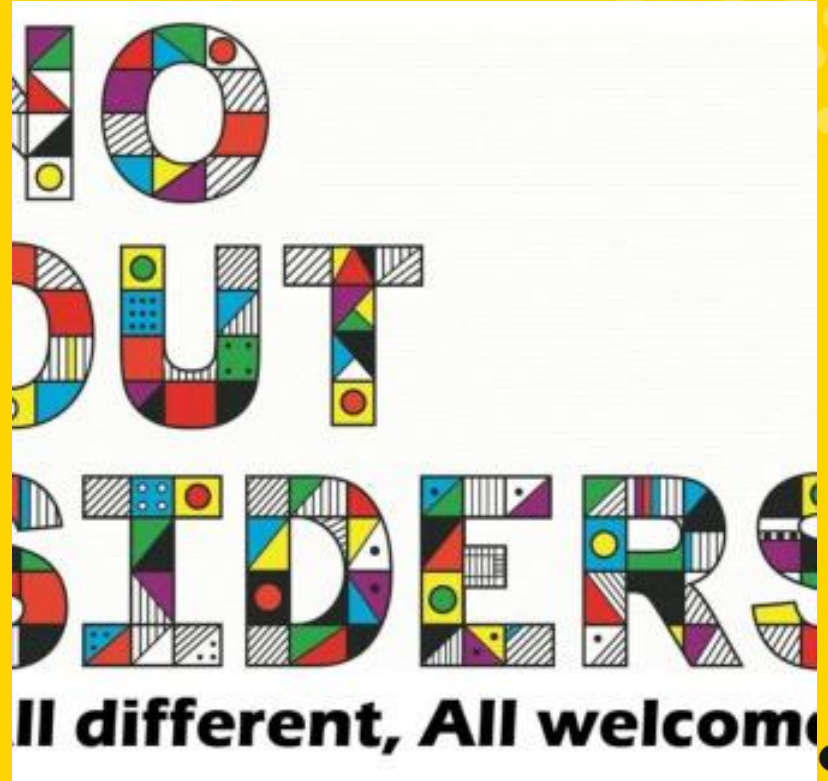
It stands out from all the other penguins.
