Being in a crowd can be exciting, but what if you couldn't see what was happening?




Not Being Able to See

How do you think it would feel to be in a football crowd and not be able to see the match?


Would you feel left out, or would you still enjoy the sounds and cheers around you?

Listening Together


Imagine you are at a football match and your friend is telling you what's happening on the field. How do you think you would feel as your friend explains the match to you?

I think the radio would be good because then I could hear everything that was happening without bothering my friend.


My friend would make me feel happy and included, but the radio might make me feel a bit separate from everyone.
