Topic

As Scientists, we shall be learning to work scientifically through completing experiments in Biology, Physics and Chemistry.

As Geographers, we will be looking at and exploring our big question: How does our extreme Earth cause natural disasters?

As Artists, we will be exploring different art work through looking, talking and drawing. We will be combining collage with other disciplines such as drawing and print making.

As Computer Scientists in IT, we shall be learning how to retrieve relevant data by creating and using a branching database.

As Linguists in French, we shall continue to use a bilingual dictionary. During our lessons, we shall apply and extend our understanding of some grammatical areas to our own simple written sentences; adverbs, nouns, verbs, adjectives and conjunctions. Also, we shall learn more about some of the famous Paris landmarks and practise speaking about them.

As **Cultural Explorers**, in RE, we will answer the question 'Does Easter make sense without Passover?' as part of our continued learning about Judaism and Christianity.

As **Global Citizens** in **PSHE**, we will learn how to understand the environmental challenges of recycling, consider the groups that make up a community and the way that charities care for each other. We will identify how people can support them and the importance of democracy at work in our local area.

As Musicians, we will be listening to and playing traditional instruments; using these to create our own improvisations.

Maths

We will be finishing off our topic on **Length and Perimeter** and start our next topic on **Fractions**. We will learn how to:

Add lengths Subtract lengths Measure perimeter Calculate perimeter

Know what a numerator and denominator are Order fractions. Know what unit fractions and non-unit fractions are Count up in fractions on a number line.



In Reading, we shall:

Use dictionaries to check the meanings of words Read books in different forms and for different purposes Discuss words and phrases that capture the reader's interest

In Writing, we shall be learning:

-To write our own narrative.

- Write a newspaper report.
