## Key Knowledge

- Some minibeasts have 8 legs, some minibeasts have 6 legs, and some have none.
- Spiders make webs to catch flies and eat them.
- To clap along to the rhythm we must clap on each syllable.
- Caterpillars form into chrysalises and then into butterflies, this is called a lifecycle.
- We can group minibeasts and animals based on their characteristics.
