Information and reminders...

World Book Day – Thursday 7th March:

Our theme for World Book Day this year is... Snuggle Up with a Book! Children will be invited to come into school in pyjamas / comfortable clothing (think tracksuits / lounge wear). No crop tops or football shirts please. Please do not buy children anything new to wear. World Book Day is designed to celebrate a love of reading, so we would prefer you to spend money on a book as opposed to a costume!



Red Nose Day – Friday 15th March:

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Our theme this year is 'Funny Fancy Dress'. As we have said with World Book Day, please don't feel pressure to buy an extravagant costume. You could wear your clothes back to front, inside out or just make

Nursery and two-year-old room places:

School currently have space in our Little Stars (two-year-old) Provision and Nursery. If your child is between 2 and 4, get in touch now about a space! If you have a younger child, please also get in touch to get their name on the waiting list.

From April 2024, the government has extended the funding for two-year-old provision to include working parents, so now ALL two-year-old children are entitled to 15 hours a week childcare (i.e. a morning or afternoon slot in our Nursery).

In accordance with our admissions policy for September 2024 and 2025, children who attend our Nursery and are eligible for the Pupil Premium (i.e. parents who receive universal credit or other forms of income support – see here https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals) will receive a higher place on our admissions list if they apply for a reception place in school.
