Miss Dunning and Mrs Laverick will continue to teacher Computing and Music & French respectively across school. Mrs Allinson will also continue to provide additional support to pupils in Year 3, 4 and 5. Miss Fodor and Mrs Phillips-Nunn will be on maternity leave and will return during the course of the year.

You will notice that Miss Bower will be teaching a mixture of Year 3 and Year 4 children. This is because our pupil numbers in those year groups are not high enough to run separate classes. They will also receive the same curriculum which ever class they are in: English and maths will be delivered at the child's year group level and all other subjects will be taught on a two-year rolling programme so all children will receive the full curriculum over their time in Year 3 and 4.
