Wider Curriculum & Experiences

Phonics – We will continue to learn set 1 letter sounds including digraphs and blend them to read words.
Maths – We will be learning about circles and triangles and gain a deep understanding of numbers to 5.
Jigsaw – We will celebrate our differences and celebrate what makes each person unique and special.
RE – We will answer the key questions 'What is Christmas?' and discuss the Christian celebration of Christmas.
Understanding the World – We will talk about woodland animals and their habitats. We will bake apple crumble and shortbread biscuits. We will learn about Remembrance Day, Diwali and Christmas. We will create simple maps.
PE – We will develop our walking skills and travelling across the room in different ways.
