## Summary & follow-up

### What are our greatest strengths?

The follow themes stood out from the survey:

- Child enjoy school and are happy coming to school.
- Friendly and understanding staff
- Support for children who need a little extra help
- Support for parents and families
- The range of clubs and extra-curricular activities
- A general improvement in the offer from school over the years

### What we could we improve?

The follow themes stood out from the survey:

- More activities available after school hours for parents that work in schools as we always miss these special events with our children.
- More consistent approach to school trips – *next year each year group will have an agreed amount of school trips, building up to residentials in Year 5 and 6.*
- Behaviour – *ensure all parents and children fully understand the policy*
- Communication – *continue to look at ways to improve this and ensure parents are assured that we always following up any issues*
