What we could we improve?

The following themes stood out from the survey:

- Assembly where parents can attend we will explore the possibility of parents being able to attend assemblies for RESPECT awards
- More homework we currently feel that our homework approach of focussing on reading, spellings and basic maths facts is enough set homework. Next year we will publicise more the different website subscriptions that we have in school (such as Reading Plus and Times Table Rock Stars) so that parents are more aware of all the different practice that pupils could be doing at home
- More information about typical days in class and photos of work throughout the week our new Instagram hopefully will show more of this
- More short, incidental positive messages this is a great idea something we can work on next year
- Interim reports in Autumn and Spring next year we will look to create a short interim report for pupil each term
