

COURSE NAME: Combined Science (9-1) GCSE - Trilogy

COURSE OUTLINE:

Combined Science gives the opportunity for all students to enjoy science and succeed in their studies. The course combines Biology, Chemistry and Physics to give two separate GCSE qualifications. Students carry out a list of required practicals, alongside their theory, which are designed to help bring science learning to life and develop students' independent thinking skills.

EXAM BOARD: AQA (9-1)

SYLLABUS: GCSE Combined Science (8464) - Trilogy

ASSESSMENT: 100% exam

- **Foundation tier** will cover grades 1-5.
- **Higher tier** will cover grades 4-9.

Six exams: 2 Biology, 2 Chemistry and 2 Physics papers. The combined science course is worth two GCSEs.
