Summer Term

Our Theme - Things that live and grow

Summer 1: This half term our topic is "What lives and grows on the farm". The children will be learning about the life cycle of a hen, visiting a farm and talking about plants and animals and learning how to care for animals and what they need.

Summer 2: This half term our topic is "What lives and grows in the garden" We will be planting different seeds and watching them grow. We will be learning about the life cycle of butterflies and studying other insects and animals that we find in the garden.

Communication & Language

This term we will be focusing on consolidating all our Phase 2 and Phase 3 phonics, with a focus on ch, sh, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oi, ur, ar, er.

Please practise reading and writing at home with your child on a regular basis.

It really makes a BIG difference!

We are working hard on using our phonic knowledge to write simple words and sentences; as well as practising our handwriting.

Maths

We will be focusing on our mastery of numbers 9-10 as well as introducing numbers 11-20. We will be teaching the children to add and take away simple numbers. We are also trying hard to double, halve and share numbers up to 20. We will be looking at 3D shapes and positions, as well as talking about weight, distance and money.

Please encourage your children to use their number knowledge to help you



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In our circle times we will be talking about how to look after ourselves and others. In summer 2 we will prepare the children for September by talking about transitions and change.

Homework

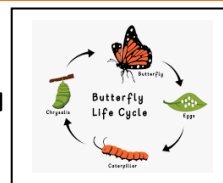
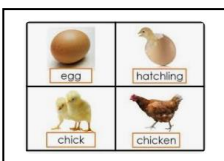
