➤ **Physical development**

Sporting activities, play opportunities, and enrichment beyond the classroom encourage pupils to stay active, build stamina, and develop positive habits that support lifelong wellbeing.

By trying new activities, facing challenges, and celebrating success, children develop confidence in their abilities and learn to manage setbacks positively within a supportive environment.

➤ **Social development**

Through group activities, shared experiences, and leadership opportunities, pupils develop empathy, respect for others, and the interpersonal skills needed to thrive in a diverse community such as Harehills Primary.
