



# What's happening in Year 4?

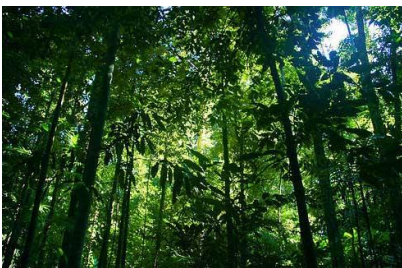

## Theme - Rainforests

This half term our theme in Year 4 is all about Rainforests and why they are important. As well as learning about the different layers of the Rainforest, we will also be learning about which different living organisms inhabit this magical and awe-inspiring place and what different types of people live there. We will also be examining why they are so important to life on earth and what would happen if they were to disappear.

We will also be developing our writing skills in a variety of ways including through poetry and writing an information text about the rainforest's structure.



**If you have a spare 5 minutes, it would be beneficial for:**

- ✓ **Your child to read to you.** Children should be reading up to 4 times a week at home.
- ✓ **Practice their spellings.** Spelling tests will be every week
- ✓ **Encourage your child to keep a diary.** This is a fantastic way for your child to practice writing every day.
- ✓ **Practice times tables.** Children should be able to quick fire their times tables and begin to know some division facts,
- ✓ **Ask your children what they have done today at school.** This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to share their experiences with you as well as practicing their communication skills.

## Swimming

Your child will be taking part in a swimming lesson each week as part of their PE curriculum.
