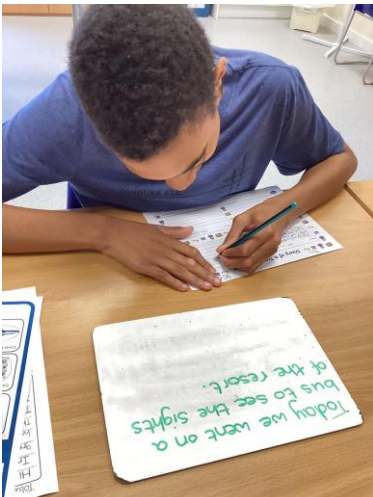
News

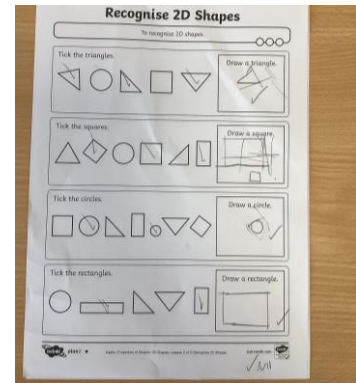
Literacy and Communication

This last half term we have been working our way up to taking a journey, using Paddington Bear as a reference. We have made passports, written about different types of transport and 'booked' our holidays with a travel agent. We have created postcards and diary entries whilst we were on our travels.



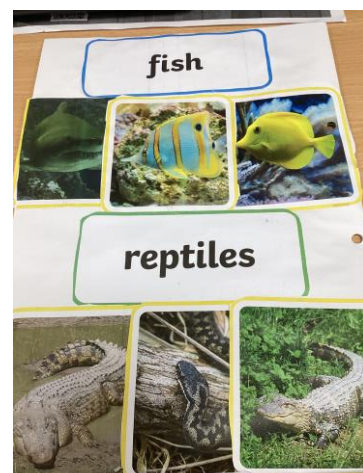
Maths

In Maths we have learnt about shape, data presentation and money. Within shape we learnt the names of 2D shapes and their properties (the number of sides and corners). We then extended our learning to naming 3D shapes and their properties in a practical way. Avon then learnt about data collection and used tally charts and bar graphs to present their data from a pupil survey. Finally, we have been learning about money and identifying British notes and coins and making set values using coins.



Science

In Science Avon class have been learning about the classification of animals. We started by sorting animals by their similarities and differences. We then developed our learning further by introducing the terms birds, fish, mammals, reptiles, insects and amphibians and classified animals into these groups. As animals live in different habitats, we then sorted animals by whether they live in the water, land or air. Finally, as a challenge we sorted and identified animals by following a variation flow chart.



Topic

This term we have been looking at Woodlands and Forests discussing the differences, the types of habitat and who or what lives there. There have been some great and lively discussions and the work the class has completed has been brilliant. We all seemed to agree that whilst minibeasts are good for the soil, they are all a bit creepy! In PE, our focus has been on cricket, we have learnt how to field, bat and bowl before playing a modified version of cricket. Finally, in ASDAN, we have been continuing with our Good Health topic and have learnt about personal hygiene, emotions and different people who help us.
