

Cognition and Learning

In Maths, we have focused on addition and subtraction, measure and time, as well as taking part in Number Day. In our addition and subtraction learning, we used manipulatives and number lines to help us complete calculations and some of us used mental maths to find the answers. In measure, we have focused on using non-standard units to describe height, length and weight as well as using rulers to measure in centimetres. During our time learning, we have focused on sequencing events and telling the time to the hour and half past.

In Science, our learning has focused on animal groups and different habitats. We have learned about each animal group, such as mammals and birds, as well as a variety of habitats, including woodlands and ponds.

In Food Technology, we have focused on following recipes step by step. The pupils and staff have worked together to create rocky road, flapjacks, pancakes, chocolate chip cookies and chocolate brownies.
