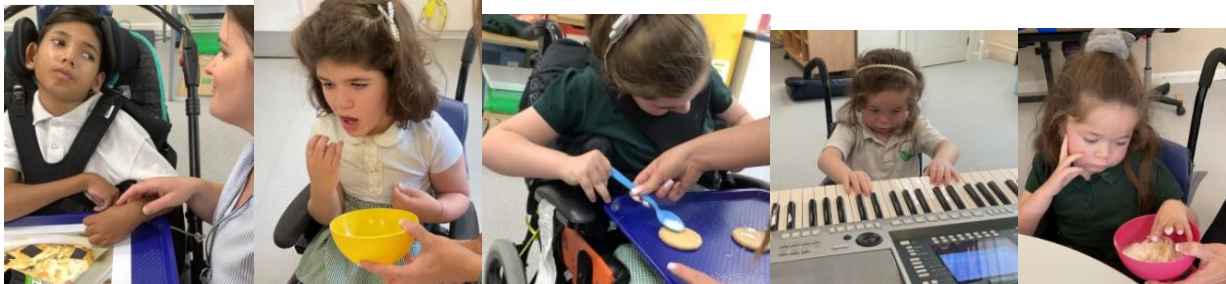
Communication and interaction

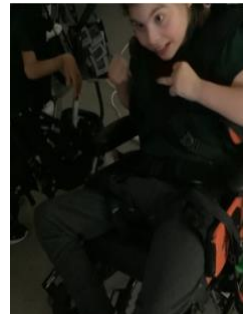
Independence, social and emotional development
