We have enjoyed our themed days such as World Book Day, Cultural Day and Movement & Regulation Day.

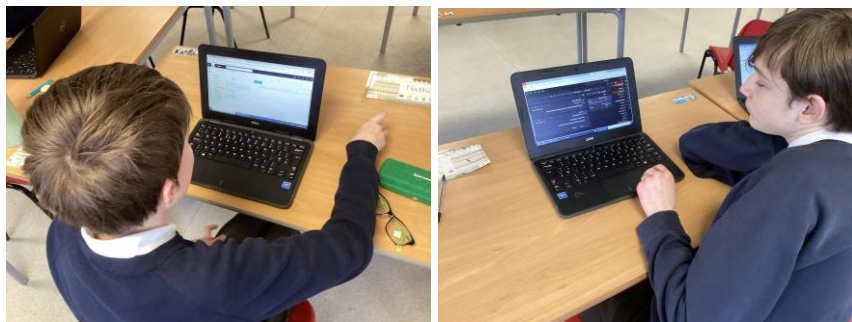


Communication and interaction

In addition to our topic work, Chelmer Class continue to develop the English skills needed to succeed in our exams. We have also been learning how to send emails to each other, which we really enjoy!

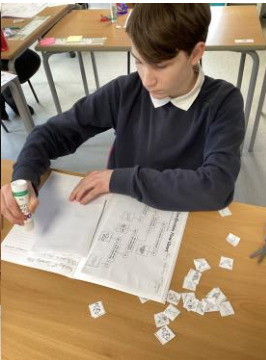
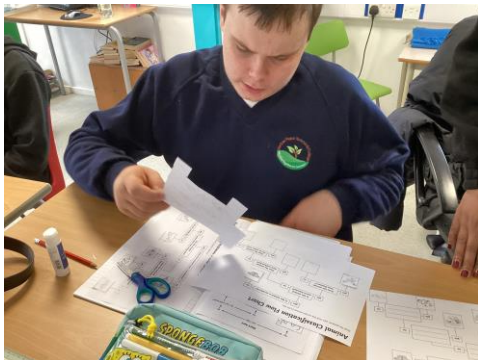
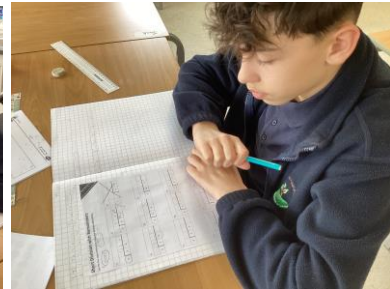
In Chelmer Class, English skills are practised in all lessons, through our social interactions, and while playing with our friends.

In Maths, we have focused on Time and Measurement. In Time we revised our understanding of the days, weeks and months of the year, transferring our skills to enable us to develop Maths skills in real life situations such as understanding bus timetables. In Food Tech we transferred our mathematical skills to measure wet and dry ingredients.

In Science our learning has been focused on animals, in science we revised our flow charts and classification keys learning from last year's topic and we have developed our categorising skills through differences and similarities. We had lots of fun using the animal models to develop our thinking!
