PLT learning & English


Our personal learning targets have become a feature of our afternoon learning with students working at their individualised targets that are linked with their EHCP. In Enterprise, students have worked at a range of different skills in setting up a small business. This tied into a MoneyBNK visit in Autumn 1 looking at money skills.

In English, students have been working extremely hard at their letter writing that was tied into their wider study of Romeo and Juliet, including exam preparation, tackling difficult situations and dramatizing the play.



Mathematics

We have been deepening our knowledge of using numbers and the number system – and using common measures, shape and space. Students have progressed in their number skills. Learners have learnt how to read calendars, have used analogue and digital clocks to read the time. Learners have been made familiar with British notes and coins and 2D and 3D shapes.



ASDAN

In Personal and Social Development this term we tackled Parental Awareness to start with. The learners put questions to new Mum, Emma, who brought her son, Marley, into class and lots of cuddles were had! The learners visited the Treehouse Family Hub where they learnt about the range of support new parents get from this valuable community resource. For Community Action, learners have heightened their knowledge of what is on offer to support the wider community in Harlow. On the practical side, learners have enjoyed litter picking in the roads and park outside the College, gardening in the College grounds and preparing the School's Christmas Grotto.

Carousel for Eagle this term has been the Butterfly workshops on a Friday each week of term. Students love the interactive and practical elements of these sessions with students learning a range of skills that promote working together, looking at feelings and emotions and exploring elements of transition into adulthood.
