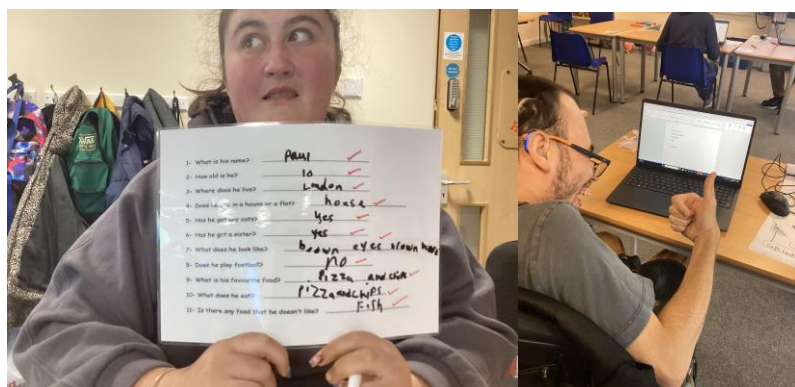
News
