
Maths

Kestrel Class have been working hard in maths this term. We have been practising our numbers skills focussing on number formation, counting to ten, and linking physical objects with numbers. In ASDAN we have been recognising time through different events. Also students have been learning about the seasons, time and times of the day.



ASDAN

Kestrel Class have taken part in four different ASDAN modules this term, this has included Maths - recognising time through regular events, developing writing skills, providing personal information and engaging in new creative activities. In providing personal information students have worked on a range of skills, learning about their home addresses, phone numbers and being able to write their full names. They especially enjoyed using the phones to call takeaway companies (role playing). Engaging in new creative activities we have explored sensory activities such as Tac Pac and reflexology and improving our communication skills.
