Thank you for continuing to **work closely with us on attendance**. We know that sometimes, getting children into school every day can be challenging, but attendance is one of the most important factors in helping pupils make progress, feel settled and confident, and take part fully in school life.

When we speak with you about attendance, we may ask questions or request details that we must record carefully. Please know this is never personal — it's simply part of our duty to ensure we're offering the right support and keeping accurate records.

As a mother of two children who both struggled with school attendance due to ill health and other challenges, I truly understand how stressful and emotional this can be. I want you to know that my door is always open — please do reach out to me, not just as your Headteacher, but also as the Senior Attendance Officer and as a Mum who's been there.
