Literacy and Communication

Maths

In Maths this term we have investigated 2D and 3D shapes. The intention has been to cement concrete understanding through direct exploration, to develop students' mathematical language, visual and spatial awareness. It has been so cheering to see students gain confidence and deeper engagement with their shape knowledge, enhanced through real-world connections – "Where do we see spheres around us?" "What shape is your drinks bottle?" Students have engaged with this work at their own level and pace.
