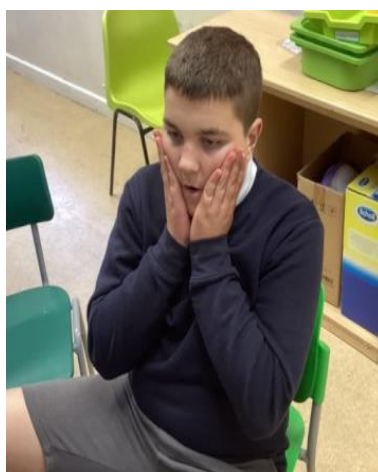
Cognition and Learning

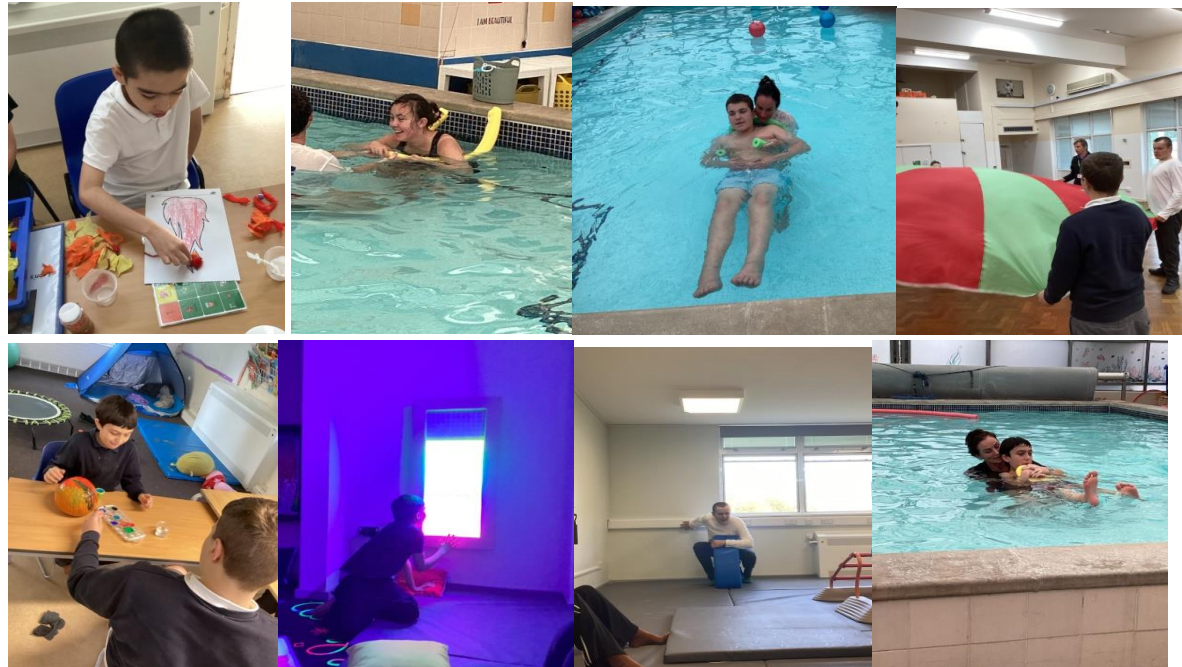
Independence, social and emotional development
