Class Welcome

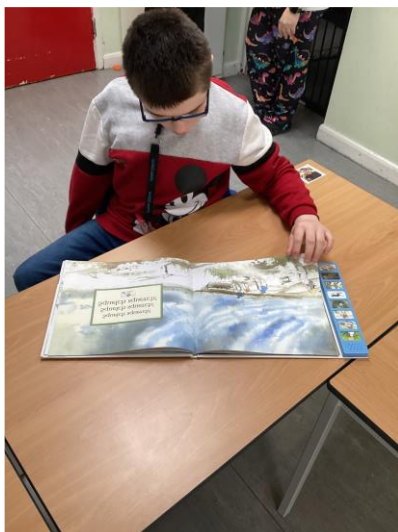
