Literacy and Communication

This term, our focus in Literacy and Communication has been on forming simple sentences and developing comprehension skills. Students have taken part in short, simple paragraph stories and answered questions about what we read, either by speaking or making choices. A highlight of the term has been our weekly visits to the local library. Students have loved choosing books to read individually or with friends, then bringing a book back to school to continue reading before returning it the following week. These visits have not only supported a growing love for reading but also helped students build road safety awareness and valuable community skills.







Maths

In Maths this term, students have been exploring shapes, handling data, and learning all about money. They particularly enjoyed discovering 2D and 3D shapes in different environments, with a favourite activity being drawing these shapes with chalk all around the playground. We also turned our classroom into a mini shop where students took part in a fun and interactive shopping game – a big hit with everyone! To bring our money lessons to life, we took a trip to our local shops, giving the children a real-world shopping experience that they thoroughly enjoyed.



Science

This term in science, our students have been learning all about different animal habitats and the natural elements, water, fire, and wind. They explored how animals adapt to their environments and investigated how the elements affect the world around us. The highlight for many students was taking part in hands on experiments, which brought their learning to life in exciting and engaging ways. It's been a fantastic journey of discovery and curiosity!





Topic

This term in **PE**, we had the fantastic opportunity to take part in the Upper School trip to the *Presidential Sporting Experience*. Students thoroughly enjoyed trying out a range of sporting activities, and it was wonderful to see their confidence, engagement, and enjoyment grow as they explored new challenges.

In **Food Technology**, we've been busy experimenting with different recipes. Chapatti continues to be a class favourite! The students have taken an active role in the entire cooking process from selecting recipes and purchasing or ordering ingredients, to preparing and enjoying their delicious creations together as a class.

In **ICT**, our focus has been on coding. Students have followed step-by-step instructions to create simple games, using skills built from previous lessons. It's been exciting to see their creativity and problem-solving skills in action as they bring their code to life!
