Avon Class have been continuing to learn more about our emotions, self-regulation and how we communicate with others. We acknowledge when we are good friends to one another on our "Wow board" display.



#### Maths

This term Avon Class has studied Number through Statistics - making choices and voting, counting quantities within given criteria, creating simple pictograms and tally charts. In Geometry, we have undertaken investigations into shapes – 2D and 3D; how we discern the difference between the two and naming simple polygons. We finished the term looking at money, where we familiarised ourselves with British coins and notes and responded to given problems involving combinations of coins and notes.








# Science

In Science we have been learning about magnets and forces. We have had the opportunity to look at and use a range of magnets and test the levels of magnetism in everyday objects in various experiments.

We tested friction and gravity by using a car that climbs up walls, and navigating the car around the classroom emergency exit door to ensure it didn't fall off!

Avon have loved Science as we do lots of fun experiments and activities.





### Topic

In **Music** we have learnt about Cartoon Music and Country Music, we have had lots of fun learning about how music is used in cartoons to help tell the stories and develop the characters and scenes. In Country music, we have listened to different singers – from the early pioneers all the way to Taylor Swift.

In **Food Tech** we have continued to become braver, smelling and tasting many things that we have never tried before. We have gone from cheese on toast and pizza to tapas this term. Some foods we now know that we **definitely** do not like (capers aren't high on the "love" list of any student in Avon).

We have looked at different aspects of the Roman Empire. In **Design and Technology** we investigated how the Romans armed themselves and the defensive tactics they used with their armour in battle. In **Humanities**, we compared Celtic Britain with Roman Britain and what life was like in the British Isles in Roman times.

In **R.E.** we have undertaken an investigation of Islam. Avon have considered the place of God (Allah), prayer, charity, fasting and pilgrimage in the life of a Muslim. We have also considered the place of the Qur'an, Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and the Mosque in the life of a Muslim.
