Wow, a great start to our new college this half term. The students have settled in so well, and our new year 12's have thoroughly enjoyed their start to the new academic year. In class we have been working extremely hard on our grammar and cementing our skills in place value. We have had a range of workshops taking place including Ore project, Butterfly project and weekly sessions on job preparation.



Literacy and Communication

In English and drama, we have been learning about our topic 'A midsummer night's dream'. In their Literacy we have been working extremely hard to improve our grammar and spelling completing weekly spelling session and working on our word classes. During our writing session we have written a letter to four of the characters acting as a counsellor on how best to support them. Students continue to develop their reading, Eagle class has been using our new programme 'Rockerbox Readers' and taking part in join class reading of Midsummer Night's Dream.



Maths

In Maths our focus has been on place value, some students have worked on identifying up to four digits supported by a place value mat. Our EL3/L1 students have been looking at number up to six digits and are applying their skills to solve word problems linked with place value. We especially enjoyed applying it sessions in playing place value top trumps.

We have started the year with our unit in learning about Rights and Responsibilities. Students have worked comprehensively looking at the responsibilities of different roles i.e. a teacher and a student, responsibilities of living as an adult at home and we have also conducted research in Harlow town on consumer rights identifying different shop return policies.
