Literacy and Communication

We created our own travel journals for each of Eddie's trips, and even shared them with some of our Upper School pupils! After half term, we focused on the book 'We all go travelling by'. Each week we focused on a different mode of transport, building sentences to describe the pictures from the book and creating corresponding artwork.



Maths

This term, Beech class have continued to work hard on developing their number skills.

We have also enjoyed learning about money, where we practiced matching and sorting coins and notes, and exchanging money for goods through both role play and in real life at the local shop. After half term, we have been focusing on shape. Pupils have learnt to explore, name, identify, sort and match different 2D and 3D shapes.



Topic

In science this term, we have enjoyed learning about light. We explored different light toys, compared light and dark, discovered how rainbows are made, learnt about the different colours of the rainbow and even made shadow puppets that we tested out in our school's dark room!
