Literacy and Communication

This half term we have continued to work on our phonics skills. We have been looking at and working on SATPIN. This half term we have worked on P, I and N. We thoroughly enjoy these sessions and take an active part. We explore objects beginning with the letter of the week, then learn how to form and write that letter. We have also been exploring different stories and have enjoyed listening to our story "Eddie the Explorer." We have made a collage of all the pictures that Eddie took in each country he went to, described what happened on the trip and identified all the things we need to use to go on each trip.



Maths

In maths this half term, we have taken part in sensory activities where we explore a variety of single- and double-digit numbers to 20. We learnt to take turns and to become more independent in the adult led input. Some of us have been learning addition to 20 and others have been focusing on number recognition. We have also learnt about money, 2d and 3d shapes.



Topic

In science, we have been learning about light and sound. We have taken part in a variety of listening and light activities such as a light themed Attention autism and environmental and familiar animal sounds.

In food technology, we have identified the utensils we need to cook and bake as well as make sandwiches, cous cous salads and a variety of wraps such as tuna sweetcorn.
