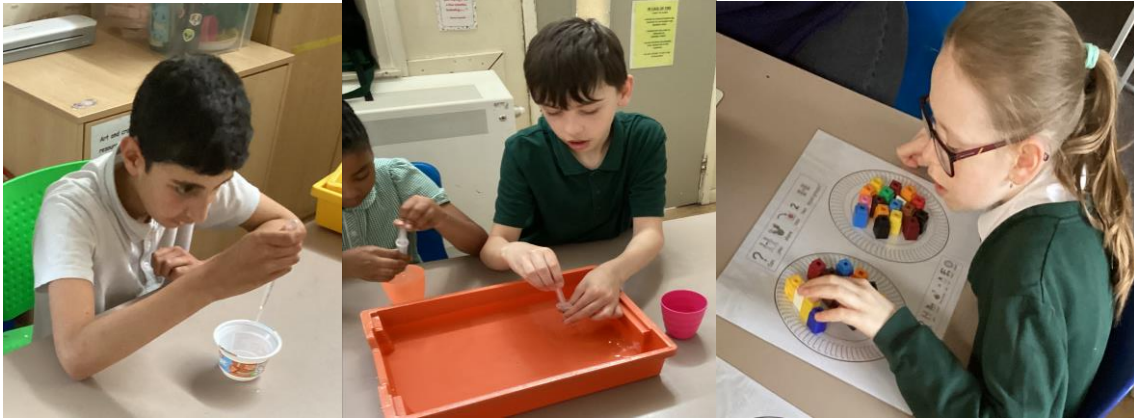
Literacy and Communication
