Ask someone in your family what you were like as a baby and look at your baby photographs. Make a list of things that you can do now that you couldn't do then.

Ask an adult to help you find photographs of your local area in the 1950s. Look carefully at the photographs and talk together about how the area has changed and what is different from how it looks now, including transport, shops, people and houses.

CHILDHOOD – Year 1

My Family

Speak to older members of your family to find out how their childhoods were similar to or different from yours. Ask them about a range of topics, such as toys, food, home and school. Draw pictures or write some sentences to record what they say.

Write a list of the people in your family. How many people are there? Can you remember all their names? How are they related to you? Make a family tree.

Make an information poster about your family. Share your poster with someone in your family for feedback.

Think of a special event from your family's history. It could be a birthday or another special celebration. Draw a picture to show what happened and write a sentence about it.
