British Values Statements: MFL

Rule of Law

Through MFL we promote the British value of rule of law by providing opportunities to:

- Take turns when playing games and/or when speaking in pairs and small groups.
- Learn and apply grammatical rules in French, such as masculine and feminine nouns and word order (e.g. “nez rouge” instead of “red nose”)

Individual Liberty

Through MFL we promote the British value of individual liberty by providing opportunities to:

- Encourage pupils to select and use appropriate materials independently when working, e.g. word mats, vocabulary banks.
- Enabling children to make mistakes and learn from them, in both written and oral aspects of learning a language.

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Through MFL we promote the British value of mutual respect and tolerance by providing opportunities to:

- Provide each other with feedback about their work, ensuring that they review their peer's work respectfully.
- Work collaboratively for tasks and questions regularly and use peer assessment to progress in MFL. Example – have a conversation in pairs about which fruits/vegetables you like and dislike, then give your partner feedback.

Democracy

Through MFL we promote the British value of democracy and tolerance by providing opportunities to:

- Taking turns to voice their opinions and views around the topics discussed in lessons, e.g. their favourite food, colour etc.
- Vote when making decisions as part of a group.
