hoof	noun	The hooves of an animal such as a horse are the hard lower parts of its feet.
fern	noun	A fern is a plant that has long stems with feathery leaves and no flowers. There are many types of fern.
glade	noun	An open space in a wood or a forest.
hibernation	noun	Animals that hibernate spend the winter in a state like a deep sleep.
feasted	verb	If you feast on a particular food, you eat a large amount of it with great enjoyment.
slope	noun	A slope is the side of a mountain, hill, or valley.
moss	noun	Moss is a very small soft green plant which grows on damp soil, or on wood or stone.
mammals	noun	Mammals are animals such as humans, dogs, lions, and whales. In general, female mammals give birth to babies rather than laying eggs, and feed their young with milk.
reptiles	noun	Reptiles are a group of cold-blooded animals which have skins covered with small hard plates called scales and lay eggs. Snakes, lizards, and crocodiles are reptiles.
amphibians	noun	Amphibians are animals such as frogs and toads that can live both on land and in water.
species	noun	A species is a class of plants or animals whose members have the same main characteristics and are able to breed with each other.
birds	noun	A bird is a creature with feathers and wings. Female birds lay eggs. Most birds can fly.
fish	noun	A fish is a creature that lives in water and has a tail and fins. There are many different kinds of fish.
