Source		noun	A process by which energy or a particular thing enters a system.
Reflect		verb	To show an image of.
Visible		adjective	Able to be seen.
Ray		noun	The straight line in which light travels to a given point.
Beam		noun	A ray or shaft of light.
Glare		verb	Shine with a strong or dazzling light.
Opaque		adjective	Not able to be seen through.
Translucent		adjective	Allowing some light to pass through, semi-transparent.
Transparent		adjective	Allowing light to pass through so that the object behind can be seen.
Illuminate		verb	To light up.
Shadow		noun	A dark area or shape produced by blocking rays of light.
