














What is a scientist?



Key vocabulary	
Scientist 	Someone whose job it is to teach or do research in science.
Comparative test 	A test that compares the effect of different things.
Observing changes over time 	To notice something and record it as being important.
Grouping and classifying 	A number of people or things that are put together and considered the same.
scientific question 	A question that may lead to a hypothesis and help us in answering (or figuring out) the reason for some observations.
Prediction 	A statement about what you think will happen in the future
Findings 	To learn the facts about something.
Data 	Information in the form of facts or numbers.
Test 	A test is a deliberate action or experiment to find out how well something works.
Material 	A solid substance, for example a cloth.
Senses 	The physical abilities of sight, smell, hearing, touch, and taste.
Absorb 	To take in a substance.
Dissolve 	To become completely mixed with a liquid.
