furniture	noun	Furniture consists of large objects such as tables, chairs, or beds that are used in a room for sitting or lying on or for putting things on or in.
slaying	verb	If someone slays an animal, they kill it in a violent way.
had a fit	verb	If you say that someone will have a fit when they hear about something, you mean that they will be very angry or shocked.
no matter	phrase	You say 'no matter' after you have just asked a question or mentioned an idea you have decided that it is not really important, interesting, or worth discussing.
member	noun	A member of a group is one of the people, animals, or things belonging to that group.
profession	noun	You can use profession to refer to all the people who have the same job.
webbed feet	noun	Webbed feet or toes have a piece of skin between the toes
ahem	convention	Ahem is used to show that someone wants to get another person's attention.
familiar	adjective	If someone or something is familiar to you, you recognize them or know them well.
expecting	verb	If you are expecting something or someone, you believe that they will be delivered to you or come to you soon, often because this has been arranged earlier.
