self-esteem	noun		Confidence in ones's own worth or abilities and self-respect.
morals	noun	moral of the story.	Standards of behaviour; principles of right and wrong
motives	noun		A reason for doing something.
dilemma	noun		A situation in which a difficult choice has to be made between two or more alternatives, especially ones that are equally undesirable.
judgement	noun		The ability to make considered decisions to come to sensible conclusions
conscience	noun		A persons moral sense of right and wrong, viewed as acting as a guide to one's behaviour
bullying	verb		Seek to harm, intimidate, or coerce
friendship	noun		The emotions or conduct of friends; the state of being friends.
confidence	noun		The feeling or belief that one can have faith in or rely on someone or something.
loneliness	noun		Sadness because one has no friends or company
behaviour	noun		The way in which acts or conducts oneself, especially towards others
happiness	noun		The state of being happy
empathy	noun		The ability to understand and share the feelings of another
sympathy	noun		Feelings of pity and sorrow for someone else's misfortune
far-fetched	adjective		Unlikely and unconvincing; implausible
