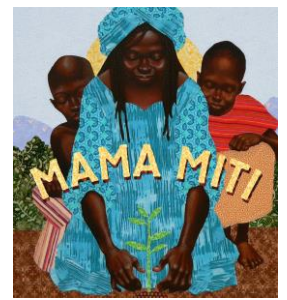

Word / Phrase	Definition / Meaning	Homonymy
salt lick	<i>A place where wild animals go to lick naturally occurring salt deposits.</i>	<i>A block of salt given to captive animals.</i>
drought	<i>A drought is a long period of time during which no rain falls.</i>	
elders	<i>A person's elder is someone who is older than them, especially someone quite a lot older.</i>	
squirming	<i>If you squirm, you move your body from side to side, usually because you are nervous or uncomfortable.</i>	<i>Twist and turn in a snake-like movement</i>
quarrel	<i>A heated argument or disagreement, typically about a trivial issue and between people who are usually on good terms</i>	
"thayu nyumba"	<i>Translates to – "Peace my people"</i>	
savanna	<i>An open grasslands, usually with scattered bushes or trees, characteristic of much of tropical Africa.</i>	<i>A female name.</i>
yam	<i>A yam is a root vegetable which is like a potato, and grows in tropical regions.</i>	
lamenting	<i>If you lament something, you express your sadness, regret, or disappointment about it.</i>	
marvelled	<i>If you marvel at something, you express your great surprise, wonder, or admiration.</i>
