traveller	noun	A traveller is a person who travels from place to place, often living in a van or other vehicle, rather than living in one place.
mended	verb	when you repair something that is broken or damaged.
altered	verb	If something alters or if you alter it, it changes.
nomadic	adjective	A member of the community who regularly moves to and from the same areas.
wove	verb	If you weave cloth or a carpet, you make it by crossing threads over and under each other using a frame or machine called a loom.
enthusiastically	adverb	If you are enthusiastic about something, you show how much you like or enjoy it by the way that you behave and talk.
yearned	verb	If someone yearns for something that they are unlikely to get, they want it very much.
bitterly	adverb	You use bitterly when you are describing an attitude which involves strong, unpleasant emotions such as anger or dislike.
stowed	verb	If you stow something somewhere, you carefully put it there until it is needed.
harness		If you harness something such as an emotion or natural source of energy, you bring it under your control and use it.
ogre	noun	In legends and fairy stories, an ogre is a large, cruel, frightening man who often eats people.
tunes	noun	A melody or a particular type of music.
vanished	verb	If something vanishes, it disappears.
musician	noun	A musician is a person who plays a musical instrument as their job or hobby.
