| supplies | noun | Supplies are food, equipment, and other essential things that people need, especially when these are provided in large quantities |
| lurked | verb | If someone lurks somewhere, they wait there secretly so that they cannot be seen, usually because they intend to do something bad. |
| stalking | noun verb | The act or crime of pursuing or following someone persistently or threateningly. |
| slithered | verb | If you slither somewhere, you slide along in an uneven way. |
| bracken | noun | Bracken is a large plant with leaves that are divided into many thin sections. It grows on hills and in woods. |
| pounced | verb | If someone pounces on you, they come up towards you suddenly and take hold of you. |
| wandered | verb | If you wander in a place, you walk around there in a casual way, often without intending to go in any particular direction. |
| shadowy | adjective | A shadowy place is dark or full of shadows. |
| awash | adjective | If a place is awash with something, it contains a large amount of it. |
| longingly | adverb | If you look longingly at something you want, or think longingly about it, you look at it or think about it with a feeling of desire. |
