scientist	Someone whose job it is to teach or do research in science.
comparative test	A test that compares the effect of different things.
observing changes over time	To notice something and record it as being important.
grouping and classifying	A number of people or things that are put together and considered the same.
scientific question	A question that may lead to a hypothesis and help us in answering (or figuring out) the reason for some ob- servations.
hypothesis	Is an idea which suggests a possible explanation for a particular situation or condition, but which has not yet been proved or correct.
prediction	To say that something will/might happen.
findings	To learn the facts about something.
data	Information in the form of facts or numbers.
question	To ask someone about something.
test	A test is a deliberate action or experiment to find out how well something works.
absorb	To take in a substance.
material	A solid substance, for example a cloth.
dissolve	To become completely mixed with a liquid.
