









## Mystery Text

English Vocabulary Organiser	
poem 	A poem is a piece of writing in which the words are chosen for their beauty and sound and are carefully arranged, often in short lines which sometimes rhyme.
rhythm 	The beat and pace of a poem.
rhyme 	Two words sound the same when spoken out loud.
visualisation 	Making mental pictures of things you read which change as the reading goes along.
perform 	If you perform a poem, you do it in front of an audience.
poet 	A person who writes a poem.
illustrator 	A person who draws or creates pictures for book, magazines or advertising.
Common nouns	The general name of places, objects or person.
Proper noun	The name of a specific person, place or object.
free verse	A poem with no set rhyme or rhythm.
alliteration 	The sound at the beginning of most words in a sentence is repeated.
