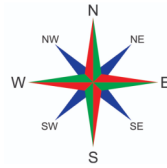


Year 4: South America

Key Vocabulary:



Ecological - groups, movements, and people are concerned with preserving the environment and natural resources.



Endangered - Animals that are in danger of extinction - dying out.



Sustainable - the use of natural resources when this use is kept at a steady level that is not likely to damage the environment.



Deforestation - If an area is deforested, all the trees there are cut down or destroyed.



Climate - The climate of a place is the general weather conditions that are typical of it.

The Amazon rainforest is home to a diverse species of animals, mammals, plants and insects.
