Year 3 Trips over the year 2022-2023

At Harrow Gate, we are committed to ensuring that the children receive a creative and varied curriculum. Educational visits play a key role in this. The importance of school visits is to give first hand experiences to children and to send them away with motivation to learn and share their knowledge

If your child does not take part in the educational visit, they will not be missing learning, as we will teach lessons in school that cover the same curricular content. Educational trips are valuable experiences that enhance the classroom, not replace it.

If you have signed the rolling consent form for school visits then you do not need to sign to give consent. We will send forms home with any children who do not have rolling consent. **We will set up MCAS with an option to pay over the academic year.** Please see the table below outlining each individual trip;

Autumn 1 - Trip to Hancock Museum Friday 16th September

Children will learn valuable skills in understanding the key features of rocks and what they can tell us about our planet, this will support their science learning this half term.

Autumn 2 - Trip the Life Centre Tuesday 8th November

To consolidate our STEM learning all about light. We are taking the children to the Life Centre where they will experience an educational workshop.

Spring 1 - Trip to Segedunum Wednesday 18th January

To begin our history topic Boudicca – Hero or Villain? we are taking the children to Segedunum where they will experience an educational workshop about Boudicca and her life. We will also take part in other activities related to the Romans and explore Roman Ruins.

Summer 1 - Trip to Jarrow Hall Wednesday 26th April

To consolidate our history topic Who were the Angle Saxons and what happened to them? We are taking the children to Jarrow Hall. They will experience two educational workshop about Anglo Saxon food and farming as well as kingdoms and battles.

Summer 2 - Trip to Hardwick Park Wednesday 14th June

This visit will support our Art curriculum where we will be finding out how artists are inspired by nature. We will be immersing ourselves in nature and will have the opportunity to make field sketches and take photographs of the nature that we see.
