**Year 5 Scientists and Musicians!** This week in year 5, we have been looking at soluble materials within science. We have investigated which materials dissolve in water and the conditions which impacted this. We have further started our DT work on bridges. As part of our first activity, we have started to look at the fundamentals concepts of bridge engineering. We have investigated different types of bridges and the features around these. We furthered this by creating bridges from recycled materials.
