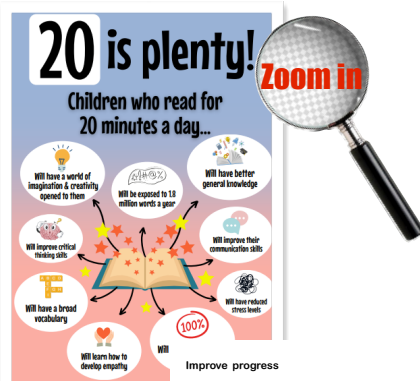
Have your say

With your feedback we can improve how we engage with our school community.

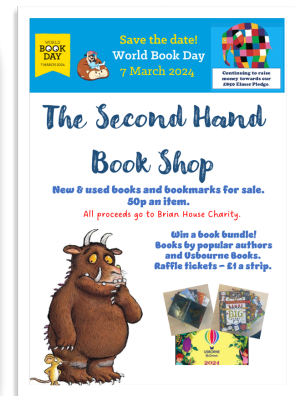

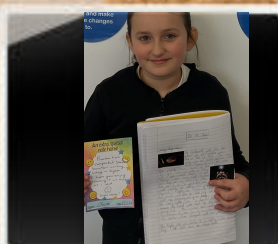
