We have so many exciting projects happening in the academy, one being OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning). Over the last few weeks in school we have introduced lots of resources into our playtimes for the children to have fun with. Each week in our assemblies we talk about what is going well and how we can develop OPAL even further, we also talk about safe play and how important it is to think about others and the space around us. The support we have received to implement OPAL has been amazing and I would like to thank the community for all their kind donations that have helped us to get started. OPAL is now integrated into the school's routine and both pupils and staff talk positively about it, the impact can already be seen through the children's social skills and interactions. Year 3 News

This half term in year 3, the children are honing their textiles skills. The children have been given a design brief of creating and designing a pencil case to store their stationery in at home. The children have looked at what is already on the market and is being sold. They have looked closely at the functions, the materials used, the colours used and the different stitches.

The children have identified four stitches they would like to try before making their final products. These were an over stitch, a back stitch, a french knot and a straight stitch. Each of the children threaded their own needle and attempted to recreate all of these stitches on their materials. The children have focused really hard to master their new sewing skills.

Next week, the children will review their stitches and decide which is the strongest but easiest to create. This stitch will then be used to sew their pencil case sides together but, more importantly, sew the zip on to seal their case.
