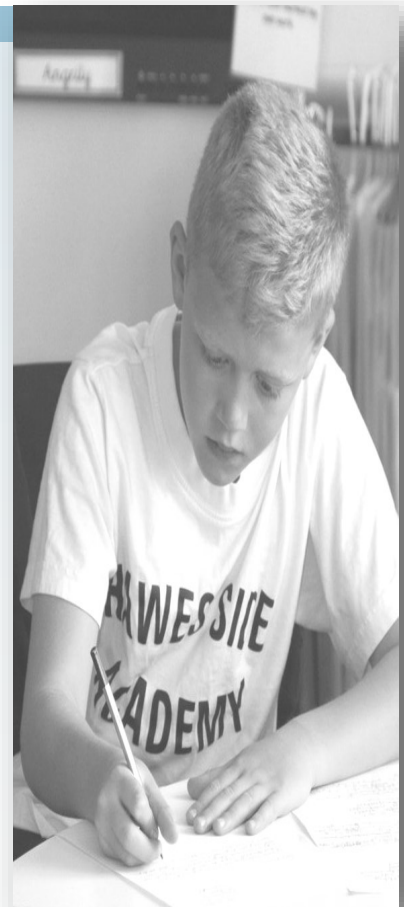
These are just a few of the exciting things happening here. There's plenty more to come!

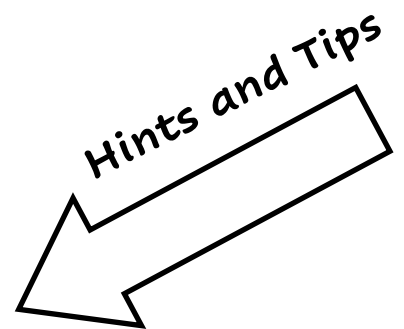
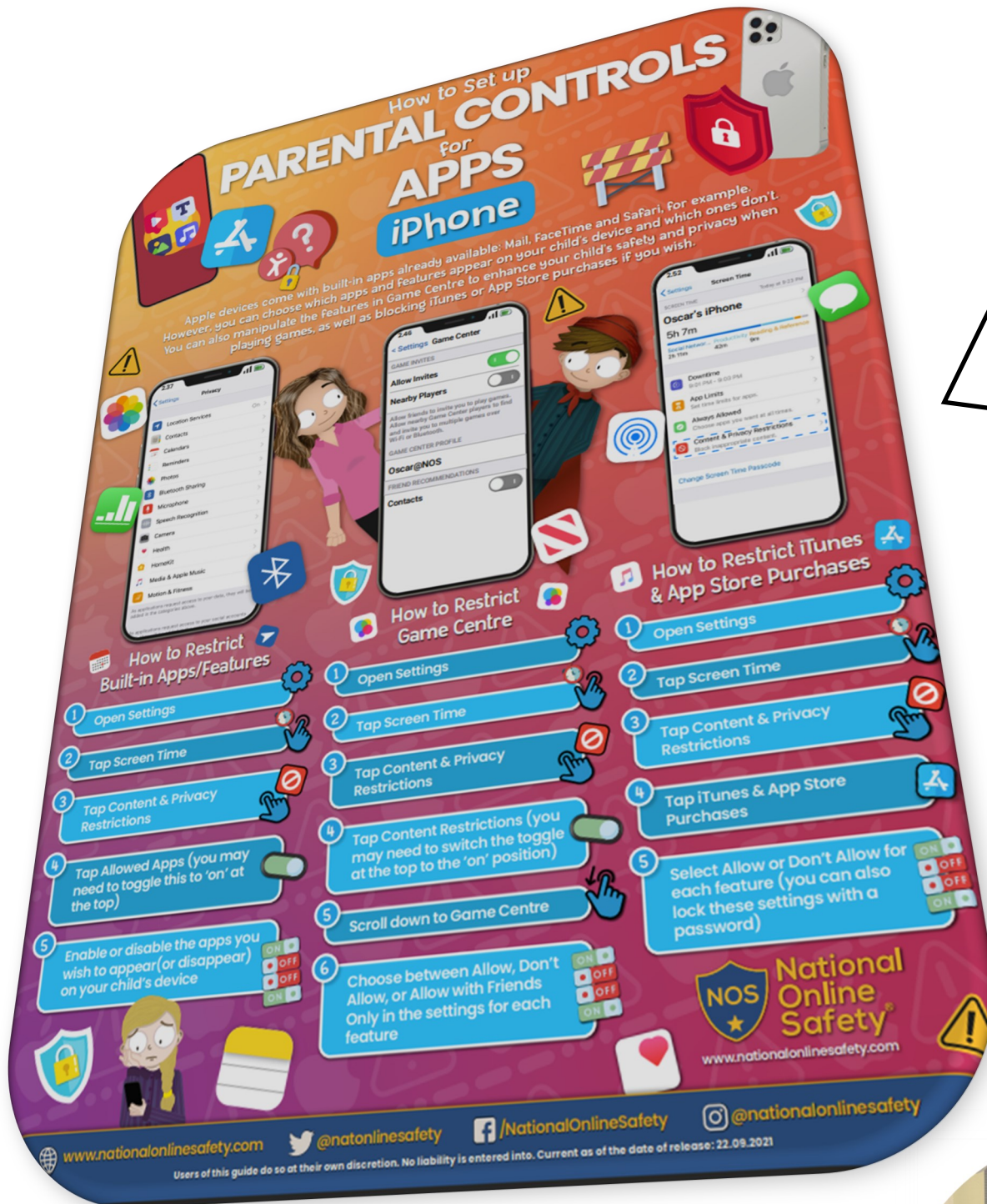
