The core learning pathway provides parents, children and staff with a list of **some** essential basic skills that, when mastered, will help with progress through the curriculum.

Foundation

PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional Development)

Fasten own coats

Dress/undress without support

Manage own hygiene (e.g. blow nose, wash hands, use knife and fork)

Be a good listener (follow rules and respond appropriately)

Understand right from wrong

Confident to try out new activities

Develop positive relationships with peers and adults)



CLLD (Communication, Language and Literacy Development)

Be familiar with at least five fairy tales

Know a range of nursery rhymes and songs

Be able to retell at least one story making reference to the main points and characters

Know each letter of the alphabet has a sound, name and shape

Orally blend and segment CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words e.g. cat, dog

Have a comfortable pencil grip and begin to form letters correctly

Talk for a range of purposes



PSRN (Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy)

Count numbers accurately up to 20

Find one more or one less than numbers up to 20

Count forwards or backwards using numbers up to 10

Use numbers in a context e.g. songs, rhymes, tidying up, counting objects
